**Tom Allen**

*Chairman, Federal Accounting Standards Advisory Board (FASAB);  
Visiting Professor of Accounting, Weber State University*

Mr. Allen joined the FASAB Board in January 2006 and serves as its Chairman. He also is serving on the accounting department faculty at Weber State University. He retired June 30, 2004, as Chairman of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) after serving in that capacity for nine years. Prior to becoming the GASB Chairman on July 1, 1995, he served one year as a part-time member of the Board. Mr. Allen was elected as Utah State Auditor in 1984 and served as the State Auditor of Utah until he resigned to chair the GASB. He is a Certified Public Accountant and a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA) where he served from 1987 to 1990 as Chairman of the AICPA Members in Government Committee. He also served on the AICPA's Ethics Executive Committee, Government Accounting and Auditing Committee, and Auditing Standards Board.

**Dan Chase**

*Training Manager, Utah Department of Human Resource Management*

Dan Chase is originally from Laie, Hawaii and has been involved with leadership training in the public, private, and education sectors and currently serves as the Training Manager for the State of Utah's Department of Human Resource Management. He is also an adjunct faculty member for the Organizational and Leadership Strategy Department at BYU and the Communications Department and Woodbury School of Business at UVU. He earned an M.P.A. from BYU and is currently finishing his Ph.D. at the University of Utah with a research emphasis on organizational and public leadership. ## Steven Allred

*Deputy Director, Office of the Utah Legislative Fiscal Analyst*

Steven Allred has been the Deputy Director of the Office of the Utah Legislative Fiscal Analyst (LFA) since July of 2007. He has worked for the LFA for 13 years, with his first assignments being to staff the Natural Resources Appropriations Subcommittee and the Capital Facilities and Government Operations Appropriations Subcommittee. Since he became Deputy Director in 2007 the State of Utah (like every other state) has gone through a period of historically challenging budget adjustments.

Before working for the LFA, Steven spent five years as a Financial Management Specialist for the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) in Denver, Colorado. This agency provides IT services for the nation's military branches on a fee-for-service basis, similar to an internal service fund. While at DISA he had the opportunity to work on business consolidation, the agency's Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) funding, and capital budgets.
